MACHPERSON, owned by Wastell and Barbara Dunham. Reserve Bitch to MARLORAIN MISS OPPORTUNITY, owned by Mr. & Mrs. Lyle Gingerich. Mr. R. A. Cross judged the entry the next day at the Sacramento K. C., placing the dogs exactly as above. "Wingover" gained a Group Four spot at this show.

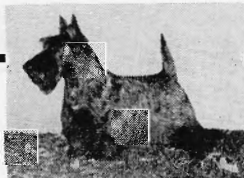

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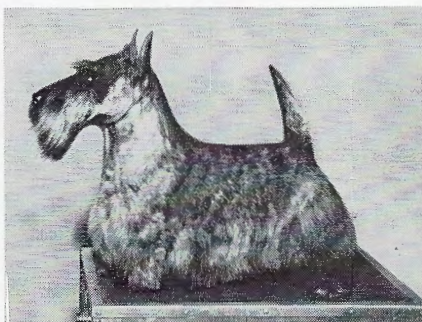
