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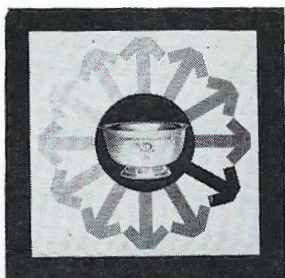
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Show of the Month

TERRIERS at the "INTERNATIONAL"

The 64th Annual Show of the International Kennel Club of Chicago was held April 4-5, 1964, drawing a total of 2,783 dogs of which 495 were Terriers. Top Terrier entry was in Miniature Schnauzers who boasted of 83, with Cairns drawing a remarkable 70, and Kerries bringing out 50. Best in Show judge, Mr. Harry Peters, Jr., selected the Westminster Best, Pennyworth Kennels' **Ch. Courtenay Fleetfoot of Pennyworth**, handled by Bob Forsyth, as Best in Show. Mr. William Brainard, Jr., of Downsbragh fame judged the Terrier Group. The top spot went to the lovely Scottie bitch, **Ch. Carmichael's Fanfare**, owned by Mr. and Mrs. Charles Stalter, and handled by John Murphy. In the second spot was the Syke Terrier, **Ch. Glamoor Twinkle Star**, owned by Glamoor Kennels, and handled by Jerry Rigden. Third went to the Wire male, **Ch. Deko Druid**, owned by Mr. and Mrs. T. H. Carruthers III, and handled by Frank Ortolani. In fourth place was the Sealyham male, **Ch. Alcide of Axe**, owned by Mr. and Mrs. William Wimer III, and handled by A. C. Ayers.

Gillis Roger Right — Ch. Lochearn Miss Twinkle), handled by Jack Funk. Winners Dog and BW was Blanche Reeg's **Blanart Bold Ruler** (Ch. Rannoch-Dune Rolero — Ch. Blanart Barcee's Dutchess), handled by Cliff Hallmark. Reserve to him was "**Impression**". Winners Bitch was "**Bonnie Doon**", with Reserve going to "**January Star**".
