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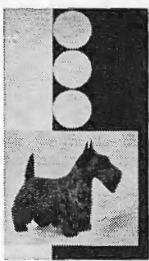
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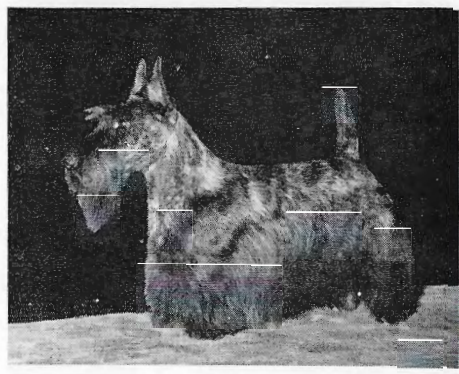

Other than Golden Gate, reported elsewhere in this issue, the only other West Coast show was Orange Empire, Jan. 31st, with Mrs. Harri-

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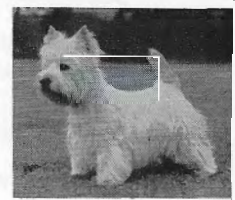

Anstamm Dark Venture**, owned by the Stamms and handled by Lena Kardos. Again the Stamms enjoyed a double win as their **Anstamm Blue Jeans** took the major and BW. WD went to the nearly finished **Revran Vivace**, owned and shown by Mrs. Richard Swatsley.

"Meet Me in St. Louis!" This is the slogan and cry of the Scottish Terrier Club of America, which will hold its first "travelling" Specialty show in St. Louis, May 23rd, in conjunction with the Mississippi Valley K. C. show. Mr. Robert C. E. Sharpe, "Of Seaglen Kennels," Ottawa, Canada, will judge.

The announcement received from Anthony Stamm, Bench Show Chairman, for the event was very exciting, and already California exhibitors are making plans to attend. This will be the first time that the parent club has ventured forth to make

their Specialty available to exhibitors in places other than New York and environs, and on the success of this show will depend all future commitments.

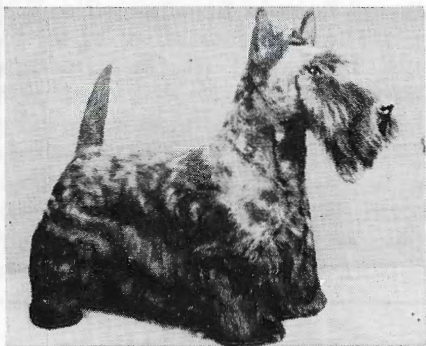
Show headquarters will be at the Bel Air West in St. Louis. They have offered shuttle service from the motel grounds to the show grounds. . . . certainly a welcome service.

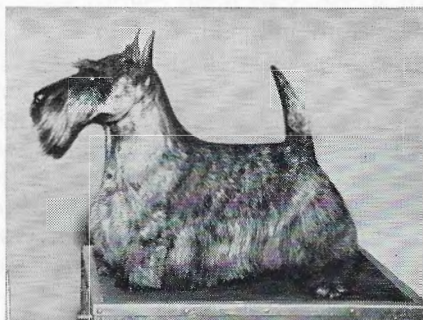

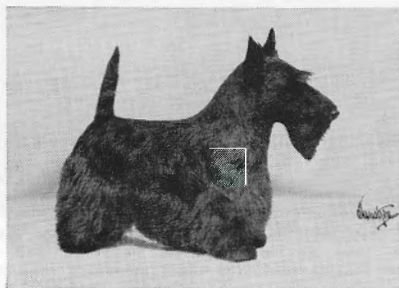

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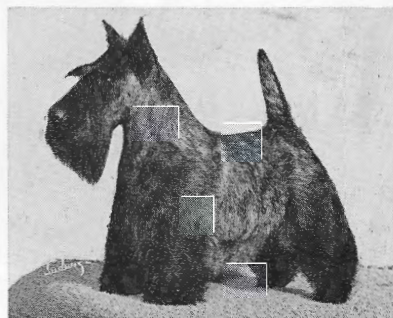
