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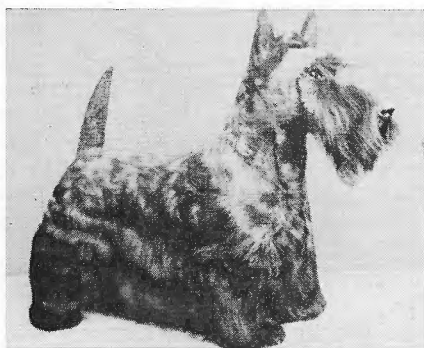

Springfield, "Lichtsme Edition" at 4 pointer at Kansas City and their "Cantie Taen" 2 points at Joplin.

In the northern Midwest area, three shows in as many states, but one BOB winner at all three. The Stamms' **Ch. Anstamm Dark Dennis** scored a Group Second at Marion, Ind. under William Pym; Group First at Springfield, Ohio under Forest Hall and Group Second at Flint, Mich. under Heywood Hartley. BOS at two of the above shows was their **Anstamm Dark Paragon**, but unfortunately none were majors.*

*We must out of necessity cut down our coverage of individual shows at times, but will always give a complete account of the winners through Reserves at all major shows, and always cover Specialties as completely as possible.

Several Western shows, and most were majors. The Arizona Circuit, March 5-6-7 saw majors in bitches at each. At Mesa, Heywood Hartley gave BOB and Group Fourth to Marlorn Kennels' **Ch. Marlorn Proud Piper**, handled by Daisy AUSTAD. WB, BW & BOS to Mr. & Mrs. Joel Harmon's **Merriland Miss Misty**, handled by Jimmy Butler. At Phoenix, Virgil Johnson selected as BOB **Ch. Anstamm Dark Venture**, owned by the Stamms and handled by Lena Kardos to a Group Second. WB, BW & BOS to Charles & Betty Pengra's **Charves Meg Merrilee**, also handled by Lena. At Tucson, "Dark Venture" repeated under Lee Murray, and WB, BW & BOS went to Frances Moore's **Marlorn Heather's Gussie**, handled by Daisy. Winners Dog at all three shows was Mrs. R. L. Hanna's **Blanart Bookmaker**, bringing home a total of 6 points.

At the Oakland, Calif. show, 4 dogs, 6 bitches and 1 Special for judge, Maurice Baker. "Dark Venture" added another BOB to his record, while WB, BW and BOS went to Mel Fertado's **Charves Mid Lothian**. The 2 points in dogs went to Buelah White's **Charves Brig O'Doon**.

Three points in dogs and four in

bitches at both the Fresno and Bakersfield, Calif. shows, April 10-11th. At Fresno, William Ackland selected as BOB, **Ch. Marlorn Proud Piper**, in an entry of 6 dogs, 8 bitches and 3 Specials. WD and BW to complete his title was **Hammond of Clifton** (Niddbank Dominie — Erica of Leonardville) owned by Joseph Allan and handled by Lena Kardos. RWD was **Ayrloch Regis**, owned by Ernest Carabba & Fred Phillips. WB and BOS **Revrn Reprise** owned by Louise Cederstrom and Connie Swatsley, with RWB going to **Marlorn Heather's Gussie**. A similar entry the next day under Robert Waters, saw "Proud Piper" repeat, but everything else was completely different.
