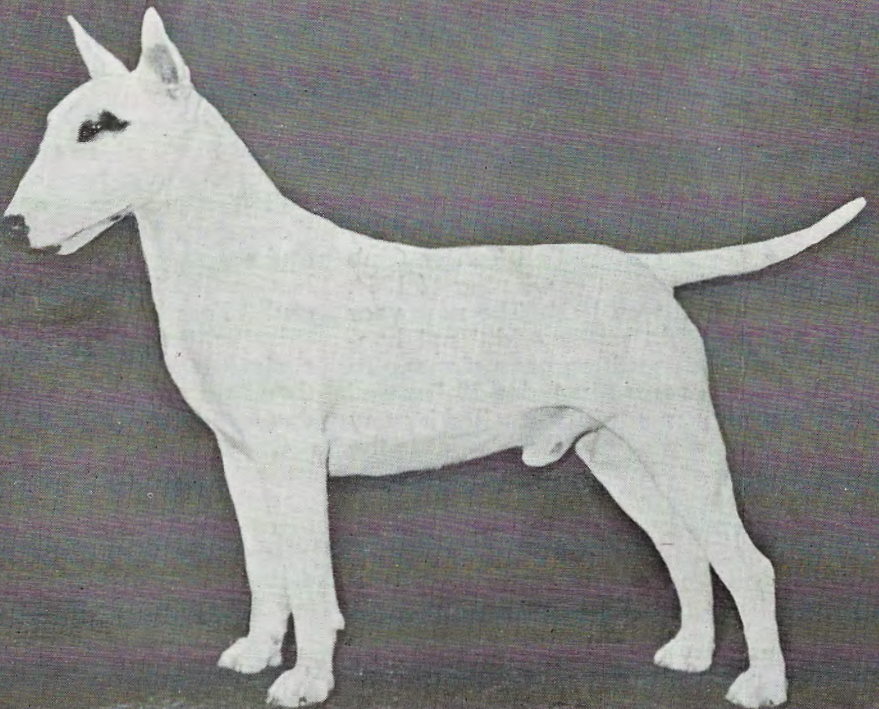

The real climax of the annual Specialty of the Scottish Terrier Club of California came about 10:00 P.M. the day following the breed judging, when Alva Rosenberg selected **Eng. & Am. Ch. Bardene Bingo** as **BEST IN SHOW** over an entry of nearly 3,000 at the new Beverly Hills Kennel Club show, June 17th. This impeccably presented black sparkler topped a large field of some 41 Scots at the Specialty under judge, Mrs. Beatrice Godsol, who placed the entry of 14 dogs, 21 bitches and 6 Specials as follows:

We so seldom hear from Helen Gaither or Nancy Lenfestey, but when we do, hey have enough "Gaidoune News" to publish a fair-sized bulletin. At the top of the list should be the winning of **Ch. 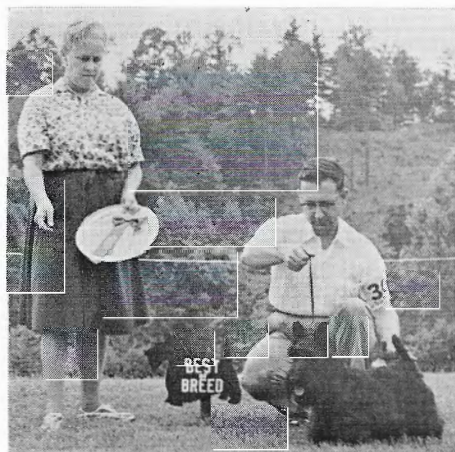

Girl has 3 majors and 12 points . . . **Gaidoune Giglet** also has 3 majors and 13 points . . . **Gaidoune Glaize**, the dam of several champions, has come out again, and won 5 points the first time shown! **Gaidoune Dream Girl**, who won 4 points the only time shown, is due to whelp to **Ch. Gaidoune Great Bear**. This will be the 6th generation at the kennel, all living, as the foundation bitch, **Ch. Glendoune Gaibonnie** (for whom the kennel is named) is still in perfect condition continuing to "rule the place."

The "Great Bear" son, **Ch. Stratherick Uranus**, co-owned by Mrs. Grant, has the enviable record of 6 Group Firsts in 8 appearances as a Specials. His sister, **Stratherick Venus**, now has 10 points.

Yes, the night watches have begun, we are up to the 59th and 61st day respectively on a pair of our fair ladies. One bit of certainty — our stubborn Scots only whelp between midnight and 6:00 A.M. I believe this to be calculated.

Two Connecticut fixtures the second week in June — Greenwich K. C. first on the 12th with Mr. Louis Murr judging an entry of 14. The Stalters' **Barberry Knowe Wintery Knight** WD, **Raab Hill Rollingstone** Reserve, his litter-mate **Raab Hill Naughty Merry-Etta** WB, BOW and BOS for 3 points, **Barberry Knowe Extra Edition II** RWB, and **Ch. Barberry Knowe Blizzard** BOB. The next day Longshore-Southport K. C. with 16 for judge Thomas Lee. **Rollingstone** WD to finish his title, and **Wintery Knight** RWD. Four points in bitches with the Stalters' **Barberry Knowe Spring Breeze** (Ch. Barberry Knowe Blizzard — Ch. Barberry Knowe Breeze By) going winners, BOW and BOS, and **Merry-Etta** taking Reserve. **Blizzard** again BOB.

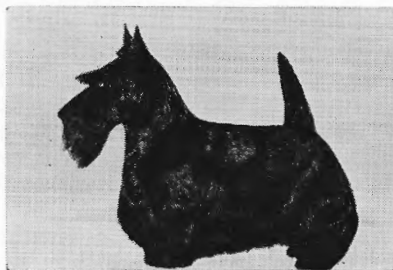
