



SCOTTISH TERRIER CLUB OF AMERICA Junior Showman Scholarship

What: \$1,000. Annual college scholarship(s) will be applied to undergraduate studies for junior members of STCA in good standing. The number of scholarships will be determined by the number and quality of applications received and the funds available through the STCA Junior Trust.

Who: High school juniors or seniors (ages 16-18) or aged out Juniors enrolled in college who are members of STCA and involved with Scottish Terrier showmanship in AKC/STCA activities.

To be eligible, the applicant and parent must be a member of STCA in good standing and the applicant must have applied and been accepted to an accredited institution of higher education (any two or four year school) at the time of application. Applicants should have an average grade point average of 2.8 or higher.

How: Simply complete the enclosed application form and submit five (5) copies of the application and all the supporting documents (official transcript, letter of recommendation, personal essay) to STCA Junior Showmanship Chair, Sueannette Maniscalco, at the following address, no later than **August 1, 2015:**

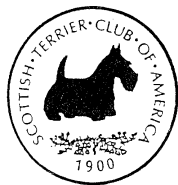

Scholarship recipients will be selected by The STCA Junior Grant/Scholarship Committee made up of 4 members from the STCA Paws for Juniors Network including the STCA Junior Showmanship Chairman along with one member of The STCA Board of Directors (5 members). The committee's decision will be based primarily on the strength of applicants personal essay and their letters of recommendation. Grade point average and participation in community service and extracurricular activities will be secondary selection factors. *Please note that the President of STCA and the members of the Paws for Juniors Network cannot serve as references for scholarship applicants.*

When: Funding decisions will be made, and applicants notified of that decision **no later than September 30 each year**. Scholarship monies will be awarded to the applicant and are to be utilized for college related expenses (i.e. tuition, books, housing, fees).

Scholarship winners are asked to submit a brief report to The STCA Junior Showmanship Chair, **by March 1 of the following year**, detailing how the scholarship monies were used, and what impact those monies have had on their educational experience. This report may be published in The Bagpiper.
