TOP FIVE IN INDIVIDUAL BREED COMPETITION FOR 1963

It was another good year for terriers in the show ring. Our "Top Five" features many top dogs that made our 1962 list (April issue), and we have indicated this below by setting their names in bold type. Several dogs repeated in heading their breeds: **Ch. Copperdale's Troublemaker**, **Ch. Alquina's Diamond**, **Ch. Radar of Monty Ayr**, **Ch. Swan Cove Highland Hercules**, **Ch. Ahtram Legacy**, **Ch. Trucote Bumble Bee**, **Ch. Alcide of Axe** and **Ch. Jacinthe de Ricelaine**. To these great campaigners, our congratulations.

In breed competition, as in registrations, **Miniature Schnauzers** led the field with 6057, well up over last year's figures. Both Scotties and Wire Fox Terriers repeated in second and third place, but competition for both was down from 1962.

The response from our statistics, using the "breed competition" system was overwhelming, therefore we are repeating it again for you this year. We do, however, want to remind you that the figures are based entirely upon competition **within the breed**, and no points are given for Group and Best in Show competition, since this basically is the method used by Mrs. **Phillips'** system. Below, in alphabetical order, appear the top five in each breed.

A letter from Blanche Reeg is offered in reference to the article on Top Producers which appeared in the January "SCOTTIE SPECIAL":

"No one recognizes the fallacy of giving credit to a tail-male stud any more than I do. Especially can one recognize this in a pedigree given on page 46 in the January issue. A "Necessity" stud is given credit for a dog when three of his four great grandmothers are out of full sisters sired by **Albourne Barty**. To a breeder, certainly as much credit can be given to "Barty" as to "Necessity". Perhaps all Scottish Terriers are a mixture of these two great dogs. At least in my experience and my observation of all recent dogs that I have liked (not always including my own), they seem to have plenty of "Barty" behind them. . . . Especially in our country, as I understand there is not much left in England, and at one time I read an article by Dorothy Caspercz deploring this."

"In Mr. Knight's article on page 51 of the January issue, he lists **Ch. Blanart Bolero** and **Ch. Merrie Oaks Windjammer** as being descended tail-male from "Red Seal", and thus to "Realization" and "Necessity". "Windjammer" is a grandson of "Bolero" through **Ch. Merrie Oaks Yodeler**, a "Bolero" son. "Bolero" is the sixth generation of champions direct from "Barty". The sequence is **Albourne Barty, Albourne Reveller,**

Heather Reveller, Diehard Reveller, Barberry Knowe Revival, Barberry Knowe Rascal to "Bolero".

"I'm writing this correction because the article would be misleading to some students of lines and breeding, and also because I believe that, while "Barty" may not have had the most influence on the number of modern champions, he has had probably the most influence on quality."

Blanche also writes with pride of the fact that the Terrier Brace win at the "Garden" made it a third for Blanart homebreds in 14 years. In 1951, **Ch. Blanart Barrister** and his litter sister won, and in 1961, **Ch. Blanart Bewitching** and **Ch. Blanart Barcee's Dutchess** won. Incidentally, the 1964 winners were sired by a litter brother to "Dutchess".

Bardene Bingo, won the Terrier Group at Marion, Ind. on Feb. 16th under judge Percy Roberts. This was only her second appearance in the show ring. Her first time out, one week earlier, saw her take Reserve at the STCA Specialty in New York under judge Ben Brown. Winners Dog at Marion went to **Scot's Rill Black Friday**, owned by Sylvia Patten. Reserve went to **Sharonlane Rustic Autumn**, owned by Russell Hilleary in dogs, and to the Stamms' **Anstamm Ebony**, in bitches.

The newly organized Heart of America Scottish Terrier Club supported the entry at the St. Joseph K. C., Feb. 2nd, offering 13 trophies (every class had one) thanks to the efforts of Mr. and Mrs. G. E. Craft, who promoted their donation. 8 of the 9 entries were member-owned. Serving Scottie people in the mid-west region, this 22 member club recently completed election of their first officers and board of directors: Gordon E. Craft, President; Robert

Leathers, Vice-President; Mrs. Dean Humphrey, Secretary; Mrs. Margaret MacDonald, Treasurer. Mrs. Jean Craft; Mr. Vernon Stuart, Mrs. Margaret Davis, Mrs. Lynn Beal and Mrs. Chuck Boyles are serving on the Board.

Winners at the St. Joseph show, under judge, Derek Rayne are as follows: WD and Best of Breed to Chuck Boyles' **Lynhaven Commander**, with Reserve to the puppy dog, **Leather's Skean Dhu**, owned by Mr. and Mrs. Craft. WB and BOS to the Boyles' **Blackacre's Queen Anne**, and Reserve to the American-Bred winner, **Brymstone Ultramatic**, owned by the Crafts.

According to Mr. John Knight's "breed competition" system, five of the top 10 terriers were Scotties! The top three on the list were **all** Scots, with Helen Gaither's **Ch. Gaidoune Great Bear** heading the list with 557 points (Scots defeated in breed competition), with 476 points to **Ch. Bardene Boy Blue**, owned by the

Stamms, and 384 points for the Stalters' **Ch. Carmichaels Fanfare**. "Fanfare" tops the breed in Best in Show wins for 1963 with nine, while "Great Bear" heads both the Group First list and Best of Breed, with 29 Firsts in Group and 58 Bests of Breed. "Maz" also heads the Group Second wins with 15, and is well on the way for 1964, having won the Group at New Haven, the week after the "Garden". Helen's new class dog, **Gaidoune Grin and Bear It**, who won the points at the "Garden", was also WD at New Haven, the "Gaidounes" as always, handled by Nancy Lenfestey.

A more recent note from Helen tells us that it is now **Champion Gaidoune Grin and Bear It**, as he finished at Harrisburg, March 14th. Being a younger brother of "Maz", this makes the 12th champion produced by his dam, **Ch. Gaidoune Gorgeous Hussy**, who already holds

the record for producing dams. This youngster went through to the title with only one defeat in the classes, and was shown in the following states: N. Y., Ohio, Ind., Md., Conn., Kent., and Penna.

And if this were not enough, **Ch. Gaidoune Great Bear** won his 11th All-breed Best in Show, March 21st at the Western Penn. K. C. show . . . WOW!

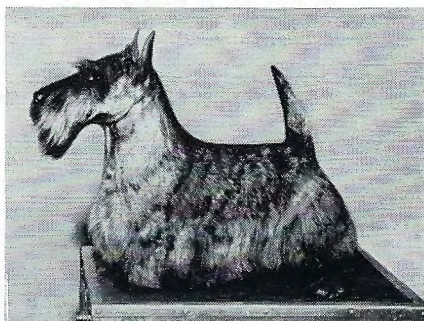
