

The winter Specialty of the **Scottish Terrier Club of America** is always the highlight of the year, with entries coming from all parts of the country. This year the Specialty was judged by the third generation Scottie man, Mr. Ben Brown of California, who must have enjoyed the entry of 23 dogs, 21 bitches and 7 Specials (6 dogs- 1 bitch). We were also fortunate to have another long-time Scottie breeder passing out the Group ribbons the next day at Westminster, where judge, Mr. Anthony Stamm awarded a **Group Second to Ch. Carmichael's Fanfare**, who was the **Best of Breed** winner both at the Specialty and "Garden". Mr. Brown's class winners are as follows:


