**Q**UITE an interesting letter written December 3rd, came from W. M. Singleton, whose famous Walsing Kennels in England, are so well known in this country. Mr. Singleton tells us that the post-war shows reveal the fact that the quality and standard of dogs and bitches in England is as strong as ever and that acquiring Challenge Certificates is no easy matter. There has been one bitch crowned a champion since the war. No dogs, although more than a half dozen have won a Challenge Certificate each. Thus, the first post-war dog champion is still a matter of the future. Mr. Singleton tells us the demand for top breeding stock from the Continent as well as from South Africa, New Zealand and Australia, is very high, with many orders going unfilled.

It was good to hear from Winifred Batt, whose Haldon Kennels are located at Guelph, Ontario. In 1946, Haldon kept a few bitches to replace some of their old "darlings" that will soon be passing on. Mrs. Batt's Ch. Haldon Emblem is now past ten years old. He was shown at the Garden in 1937, when he was ten months old and he went clear through to Reserve Winner. Unfortunately Emblem has developed a cataract and is not in good shape. Mrs. Batt kept her old "Storm" until he was past fifteen. One of the Haldon-bred Scotties, Haldon Gale Michael recently celebrated his sixteenth birthday, and he is hale and hearty and very active.

R. J. McLaughlin of Lynscot fame, tells us his Ch. Lynscot Deborah pictured in this issue, recently whelped a lovely litter by Ch. Relgalf Rebel Leader. Deborah was Best of Winners at the summer 1945 S.T.A. Specialty, Winners at the last Winter Specialty, and she finished shortly after at Province, where she was Best of Breed and third in the group.
