Wires

The Mid-West circuit was a great one for Wires and the number of Best in Shows they accounted for was phenomenal—Wildoaks Weltona Frizzette at Detroit and Cincinnati, Dr. Gage's Wycollar Diamond Merchant at Canton. At Louisville Warily Coquette took the highest place.

Walter M. Toole's Westbourne Teetotaller came out during the latter part of the mid-western circuit and then there seemed no stopping him. Winners at Cincinnati and St. Louis and several later events. Must have captured his title in just a few weeks.

Wm. Shanks, of Cleveland, has a grand home-bred in his Elmont Double Up. One of the greatest ever bred in this part of the country. Winners at Chicago.

Mrs. W. D. Wilkinson, of St. Louis, did some substantial winning with her great little bitch, Dancing Girl.

It is rather interesting to note that the Wire Haired Fox Terrier, Gamester's Pep, owned by the Green Shingle Kennels, Paoli, Pa., and a grandson of Ch. Will O Wave Gamester, is the sire of two offsprings which were the winning puppies at the two greatest Fox Terrier shows held in the United States last year. Prides Hill Grecia was best puppy bitch at the American Fox Terrier Specialty Show, and Prides Hill Bounce was the winning puppy dog at Westminster.

Tough Break

Old Black Joe has been shown as consistently and as sportingly as any Wire that was ever born—in coat or out of coat, tired or fresh, the Bowers swelled the Wire entries with Joe. Along came the Toledo show and Joe annexed Winners and his final three pointer that would make him a Champion. Now the word comes that due to some violation of Rule 2 on some of the other exhibitors' part, some of the dogs are disqualified, cutting the show down to a two pointer, and so

R. C. Bondy Makes English Champion

Beau Brummel, the Wire which R. C. Bondy of Wildoaks Kennels shipped to England to be shown on the English circuit, has completed his English championship, and his kennel mate, Bobbie Burns of Wildoaks, has already acquired two challenge certificates. One more certificate and Bondy will have made two English champions, a feat never before accomplished, or even attempted by an American with American bred Wires.

Scotties

Scotties were probably second only to Wires as contenders in the Terrier group in the mid-west. Toledo and Chicago saw genial Bob McKinvern's Ch. Ardmore Keepsake capture Best in Show. Bob can sure turn out these Best in Show type Scotties with great regularity.

Halden Maureen went Best of Breed at Cleveland in a really beautiful bitch of exceptional type and quality.

Wm. D. Bartlett, of Cleveland, is gathering together a strong string of Scotties. His bitch, Meg O Cannie Wee Lass and Walnut Bumper, a recently imported dog have done some consistent winning.

Scotties are undoubtedly on the up and up in the mid-west. They have been quite the rage in the east for some time and their popularity is spreading rapidly.

Irish Terriers

Some smart entries of Irish came out on the Mid-west circuit. The veteran Ch. Gallo per was Best of Breed at Cleveland. He lasts wonderfully well for he is no longer a child.

Wahoo Lady Peggy is a fine bitch that did herself well and picked up some useful points. In dogs, Vanlo Vagabond, Bankhall Blarney of Cavan, Goldstick of Ardara Farm all had their turn at the top and all are good typical Micks.

Bull Terriers

Bull Terriers rose to new heights along the mid-west circuit. Cylva Barbara kept them out in front by going Best in Show at Huntington, Ill. Same lady won a hot Terrier Group at Cleveland, topping the Best in Show winning Wire at Canton.

Cincinnati is a hot bed to Bull Terriers and here the Westminster winning dog had to be content with Reserve as J. Daikin's Son of Daiken was on top here. He is locally bred. The Cincinnati bitch, Pebbel Again, was Best of Breed at Washington, Pa.

Manchester Terriers

The Manchester Terrier is presumed to have originated around the Manchester district in England, where rat killing and rabbit coursing were great sports with the rather poor class of people who lived in this neighborhood. With the idea of producing a dog that could be used for both of these sports, a Whippet bitch was bred to a well known, cross-bred, brown Terrier, celebrated for his rat killing. The result of this cross was the origin of our present day Manchester.

Few breeds are superior to a well bred Manchester. He is an intelligent, alert companion, and the most aristocratic looking probably of all the Terriers. Few dogs present the sleek, high bred appearance that these little fellows do. The Manchester resembles the Doberman to a remarkable degree, except for his size. Both have the same beautiful coat, the same general conformation, the same head, and above all the same alert, noble appearance.

At the recent Cincinnati show Leonard Schriever had a beautiful exhibit of Manchesters, and Dr. Chase W. Reed of Bakerstown, Pa., has a very fine dog in The Abbott, a son of Int. Ch. Black Vic.

Dandie Dinmonts

Pepper of Stanwich, imported from England last summer by Miss Ester Bird of Scarsdale, N. Y., is the proud father of an exceptionally nice litter out of Rowan Birkie also owned by Miss Bird.

The Ark of Scarsdale, N. Y., write that two of their puppies are certainly showing that it is instinctive for a Dandie to go to ground, as these two youngsters invariably dig under the barn for their naps—covering themselves entirely, so nobody knows just how deep they go.

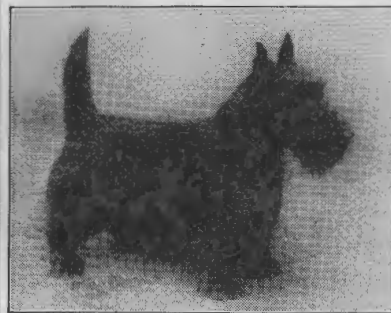
