1965 Top Producing records are now beginning to take shape, with nine months recorded (Gazette, Jan.-Sept.) and official. Already some 62 new Scottie champions have been confirmed, and of these only 4 were imports; far less than in most years. So far this year, **Ch. Barberry Knowe Merrymaker** is far and away the top producer, with five get already confirmed: Chs. Barberry Knowe Extra Edition & Frolic and Chs. Raab Hill Fashionette, Rollingstone and Naughty Marietta, the latter three all of **Ch. Fashion Felicity**, who not only finished her title this year, but is presently tied for 1965's Top Producing Bitch, with **Brymstone Bittersweet**, the dam of Ch. Leathers Mighty Edition, Skean Dhu and Sma Prisie, all sired by **Ch. Special Edition**, who incidently, is the sire of "Felicity" bringing his total to four for the year, and a second spot on our annual list to date. Tied for three place among the sires are **Ch. Bardene Boy Blue** and **Ch. Marlorain Proud Piper**. "Boy Blue" is the sire of Ch. Anstamm Blue Flare, Ch. Scotts Rill Black Friday and Ch. O'Mc Dee's Bryndi of Aldon. "Piper" is the sire of Chs. Marlorain Bit O'Honey, Candibar and Heather Astronaut, the first two out of **Ch. Marlorain Lollipop**, who is tied for second spot among the bitches with this pair. The other two bitches with
