## Diehard Dope

**R**ELGALF Kennels has won the Scottish Terrier Club of America 1947 Best of Breed Trophy, donated by Mrs. Winant, according to the Club's Jan. announcement. Relgalf also won the Club's Francis G. Lloyd Trophy as well as the Club's Trophy for American-bred Bitch.

Relgalf piled up 99 points with Ch. Relgalf Rebel Leader for both the Best of Breed trophies—one of the highest scores ever recorded.

The Club's Puppy Dog Trophy was won by Mrs. J. G. Winant and both the American-bred Dog Trophy and the Puppy Bitch Trophy were won by Mr. and Mrs. C. C. Stalter.

Carl H. Stewart Jr., has been elected President of the Scottish Terrier Club of Maryland. Others chosen are Thomas Shafer, Vice President; Miss Catherine Luken, Secretary and Mrs. Robert Redding, Treasurer. Wm. Osterman and Mrs. Harry Grady were elected to the Board of Directors.

While Diehards totaled 4,545 registrations in 1947—only six less than the total for Chihuahuas, the Chihuahua Club of America benched 105 at its Specialty Show in Chicago Nov. 23rd, as compared with 47 at the last Scottish Terrier Club of America Specialty May 23—two and a quarter times as many.

The new breed pamphlet of the Scottish Terrier Club of America, under preparation since 1946, will not be published until after the proposed revision of the Club's constitution and by-laws have been voted on, so as to include them in it. The Club hopes to complete action on them in February, although if the changes are adopted by the membership at the annual meeting, February 10th, they still must be approved by the American Kennel Club, so it is unlikely the pamphlet will be published until around March or April.

Here's a thought for fanciers to mull over: Why should revision of a breed standard be exclusively the right of a parent club? There are in our breed probably ten times as many active breeders and exhibitors who are NOT members of the parent club as are members, yet

they have nothing to say about any changes.

In so serious a matter as revising a breed standard, why cannot the American Kennel Club require that any changes be voted upon by ALL members of ALL the breed's Specialty Clubs?

Kinclaven Lucky Parcel placing Best Opposite. Bred by Marie A. Stone, she is a daughter of Ch. Kinclaven Casanova and Ch. Kinclaven Lucky Bit. Best of Winners was Keith P. Rogers' Mac R's Kiltan, a homebred son of Ch. Edgerstoune Benefactor and Edgerstoune Late News. Marlu Dark Mischief, now entered in the name of C. H. Werber, Jr., got the bitch points.

At the Glendale, Calif., show on December 7, Z. B. West judged an entry of 18. Bryce Gillespie's Ch. Bothkennar Kilroy was his choice for Best of Breed. He is by Ch. Bothkennar Spitfire ex Ch. Edgerstoune Betty and is a homebred. Best of Winners and Best Opposite was Bettha A. Russell's Glenby Bonnie, C.D. A homebred, she is a daughter of Ch. Wedgewood Andy O'Briarcroft ex Paisley Pomathorne, C.D.
