**T**HE annual meeting of the Scottish Terrier Club of America will be held at the Hotel McAlpin in New York on Saturday evening, February 12th. The nominating committee has nominated Mrs. Marie A. Stone of Milwaukee, in place of the late Bryce Gillespie, who had been placed in nomination for the Board of Governors.

We understand there is a growing interest in forming a new Scottish Terrier Club in the Midwest. The ambition is to form a strong Club and eventually stage annual Specialty shows. We also hear rumors of a Scottish Terrier Club being organized in the Philadelphia area.

The 1949 Westminster has an entry of 59 Scotties, up 14 over last year's entry of 45. This is the second highest Terrier entry in the show, being exceeded only by Kerry Blues. The combined entry of Fox Terriers is, of course larger, but they are listed separately—49 Smooths and 49 Wires.

On January 7th the newly elected officers of the Scottish Terrier Club of Michigan assumed their posts. James Wheeling of Hazeldean Kennels was at the helm as President. Chas. McKinven, son of the illustrious "Bob" McKinven of Ardmore fame, assumed the office of first Vice President and George Miller as second Vice President. Peter Babisch of the Yankee Pride Kennels continued as Secretary. Mr. Babisch was recently elected President of the Macomb County Kennel Club. He may be contacted at Route 4, Box 23, Royal Oak, Mich. Miss Beulah Finch of Lallan Kennels is Treasurer this year and Mrs. Ester Miller will act as Recording Secretary.

With their first successful year completed, the Scottish Terrier Club of Michigan are hoping for further progress in 1949 and want to thank all of their loyal friends who gave them assistance during the past year.

Westminster and later Morris and Essex and other big Eastern shows.

Shieling Kennels owned by Mr. and Mrs. T. H. Snethen, have been notified that their Ch. Shieling's Master Key again placed among the first ten dogs of 1948 for Best in Show wins. This is particularly noteworthy as Master Key was first shown in 1948 in June and then only up until November 2nd, really less than five months showing and we believe only fourteen times—twelve at All Breed events where he was five times Best in Show and twice at Specialty shows where he was tops both times. Certainly a great record.

The Ederstoune Trophy for most points, Best of Breed, was Marlu Farm Kennels with Ederstoune second. *Divisional Trophies* Division No. 1, for *Best of Breed*: Marlu Farm Kennels. *Puppy Dog*: Mr. and Mrs. Chas. C. Stalter. *Puppy Bitch*: Ederstoune Kennels. *American-bred dog*: Mr. and Mrs. Stalter. *American-bred bitch*: Mr. and Mrs. Stalter.

*Division No. 2, Best of Breed*: Brawyn Kennels. *Puppy Dog*: Relgalf Kennels. *Puppy Bitch*: Relgalf. *American-bred dog*: Dr. and Mrs. B. K. McInnes. *American-bred bitch*: Mr. and Mrs. Wm. J. Macaulay.

*Division no. 3. Best of Breed*: Bryce Gillespie. *Puppy Dog*: Mr. and Mrs. G. D. Ryall. *Puppy Bitch*: Tam Lin Kenbrick.

The same trophies will again be offered in 1949. All members of the Scottish Terrier Club of America are eligible to compete. Divisional trophies are covered by the following divisions:

*Division No. 1*—(East and North Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Illinois, Indiana, Maine, Maryland Massachusetts, Michigan New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont and Wisconsin.

*Division No. 2*—(West and South) includes Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, New Mexico, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia and West Virginia.

*Division No. 3*—(Pacific Coast and Northwest) California, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington and Wyoming.

Point values on the various trophies are the same as the A.K.C. In other words, if a dog wins three points it gets a three point rating toward the trophy. In the event of a tie, the Westminster show will have a plus rating. If a dog or a bitch is owned by two or more persons, each must be a member of the Club. In the event that a dog or bitch is owned by two or more persons to be eligible for a Divisional trophy, at least one of the owners must reside in the Division where the dog or bitch is shown.

**T**HE American Sealyham Terrier Club is holding a Specialty in St. Louis, on March 19th, in conjunction with the St. Louis Associated Specialty Clubs. Ernest Joresco will judge and there is a beautiful trophy list which includes Sterling Silver Trophies in all classes. Gilbert H. Priesmeyer is Chairman of the Bench Show Committee which includes Walter D. Gilmore, Miss Thelma Miller and Herbert A. Steinmeyer. Mrs. Gugerli is superintending the show.

The day after the Specialty show the Mississippi Valley All-Breed show will be held—both shows will be in the Arena. The two events on successive days certainly offer a splendid chance for top points for a minimum of time and trouble. St. Louis is noted for good Sealy entries and with the added attraction of a Parent Specialty Show both events should be five pointers—and remember, St. Louis has Southern Rating, which is something else to make these shows MUSTS on the Spring calendar.
