The Specialty and Morris and Essex

MAY 28th was truly a red-letter day for Scotties, for on that Saturday at the great Morris and Essex show, Ch. Walsing Winning Trick of Edgerstoune, owned by Mrs. John G. Winant, went clear through to Best in Show All Breeds, after having gone Best in Show the day before at the Specialty. Out of twenty-five shows, Winning Trick has won twenty-three groups and placed Best in Show, fifteen times—a truly amazing record.

The Scottish Terrier Club of America held its summer Specialty show at Garden City, L.I. on Friday. J. McOwan judged the regular classes and S. Edwin Mergree the Futurity Stake. The entry for the Parent Club's show was certainly nothing to brag about—there were 5 Puppy Dogs and 5 Puppy Bitches in the Futurity, and in the regular classes, 9 dogs, 22 bitches and 3 Specials. Fortunately there were very few absentees, according to our catalogue, a total of 2 bitches.

In the Futurity, Mr. and Mrs. Albert C. Ayer's Ayerscott Angela, a daughter of Blanart Buccaneer ex Hi-Scott's Beloved of Blanhart, headed the bitch puppies and then was Best Futurity puppy over Mrs. W. A. Wymer's Jack McDuff III, a litter brother to the winning bitch puppy. It is interesting to note there were three puppies from this litter entered at the show, the third being Blanche Reeg's Blanart Bluebell, which placed fourth in the Bitch Futurity Stakes.

In the regular classes, Mrs. T. H. Snethen's Shieling's Premium, a son of Ch. Shieling's Signature ex Ch. Shieling's Luminous took the points in dogs and then bowed to his litter sister, Shieling's Insignia for Best of Winners. Reserve in Dogs was Edw. F. Moloney's Goldfinder's Kilroy, a son of Ch. Edgerstoune Spitfire ex Heather Maisie. The Reserve in bitches was Marlu Farm Kennels' Marlu Miss Twinkle, daughter of Ch. Deephaven Red Seal ex Ch. Marlu Mi-

lady's Flirt. Both the Winners and both Reserves were homebreds.

The Specials Only class consisted of Mrs. Malby's Ch. Rampant Bright Star, Blanart Kennels' Ch. Blanart Barcarolle, Mrs. Winant's Ch. Walsing Winning Trick of Edgerstoune and the Best of

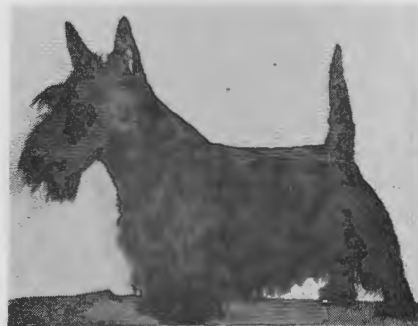
