The Scottish Terrier Club of Michigan is celebrating championships for two of its local members. Mac's Welton Pixey's Bairn recently purchased by Chas. McKinven's Ardmore Kennels was Best of Breed and fourth in the group at Oakland County and Best in Show the next day at Pontiac. The transfer of ownership from the Wm. J. Macaulays had not gone through, but she was owned, and shown through the last three victories by Mr. McKinven. The other champion is Lallan Kennels' Kinclaven Ballyhoo who finished for the title under Marie Stone at South Bend in June. Now that the club has its two Match shows behind it, it is making plans for its first point show with the hope that, due to its central location, Detroit may be the eventual annual meeting place for the Scottie world.

The club has had a little touch of sadness in the loss of Mrs. Marie Lynas' Lynocks Malcolm the first Michigan Scottie to win a C.D. degree both in this country and Canada. We do appreciate the news from this club sent us by Mrs. V. A. Coolidge, Chairman of the Publicity Committee.
