Today, TROPHIES are defined as a prize at an event; AWARDS are given for special achievements in a category as defined by the donor, such as Annual Awards for achievement over the past year. If your donation is an award for points achieved during an award year, January 1-December 31, it will be called an Award, not a Trophy.

The award shall consist of a cash prize in the amount of \$100.
