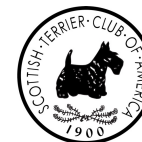

** [From Philadelphia International Airport and points south](#) –Take I-95 N which becomes I-295 East. Take the US-1 Bus/PA-413 exit, EXIT 44, toward Levittown/Pennel. Merge onto E. Lincoln Hwy/US-1 Bus N. toward Levittown. Turn left onto Oxford Valley Rd. Hotel will be on your right.

[From New York City](#) – Follow the New Jersey Turnpike South to Exit 7A. Take Interstate 195 West to Route 29 North. Go through the tunnel and take the exit for Route 1 South to the Oxford Valley Exit. Turn left at the traffic light, and the hotel will be one mile further on the left.

** From I-95 – Take I-95 South to Exit 46A to Route 1 North. Follow Route 1 North to the Oxford Valley Road Exit and turn right at the light. The hotel will be on the left.

**[From Harrisburg/Lancaster](#) – Take Pennsylvania Turnpike East to Exit 351. After toll both, take Route 1 North to the Oxford Valley Exit. At the top of the ramp, turn right and the hotel is ¼ mile further on the left.

I. Directions from In the Net Sports Complex to Sheraton Bucks County Hotel, 400 Oxford Valley Rd., Langhorne, PA. Start out going SW on Airport Rd. toward Taxiway Dr. Turn left onto S. Forge Rd/PA-117. Pass through 1 turnabout. Turn left onto Horseshoe Pike E/US 322E. Horseshoe Pike E becomes Lebanon Rd/PA-72. Take the PA Turnpike ramp. Merge onto I-76 E/PA Turnpike via ramp on left. Stay straight to US-1 Exit 351 towards Phila/Trenton. Merge onto US-1 N toward Morrisville. Follow Route 1 North to the Oxford Valley Exit. At top of ramp, turn right. Hotel is ¼ mile on left. (Approx. 1 hr. 45 min. 104.1 Miles)

2. Sheraton Bucks County to Macungie Memorial Park, 50 N. Poplar St., Macungie, PA from 400 Oxford Valley Rd., Langhorne, PA. 1 hour. 25 minutes via PA-309N refer to Google Maps for complete directions and driving options.

From New York • Follow I-78 west, past Bethlehem and Allentown. Exit onto Route 100 South (exit 49-A). • Follow Route 100 south for six miles to Macungie. • Turn left onto Poplar Street (directly across from the Bear Swamp Restaurant).

From Philadelphia • Follow I-476 (northeast extension of Pennsylvania Turnpike) to the Lehigh Valley interchange (Exit 56). • Then follow Route 22 westbound for four miles (Route 22 will combine with I-78). Exit onto Route 100 at exit 49-A. • Follow Route 100 south for six miles to Macungie. • Turn left onto Poplar Street (directly across from the Bear Swamp Restaurant).

From Harrisburg • Follow I-81 to I-78. Exit onto Route 100 at exit 49-A • Follow Route 100 south for six miles to Macungie • Turn left onto Poplar Street (directly across from the Bear Swamp Restaurant).

From Pottstown • Follow Route 100 north. • At Shimerville, Route 100 takes a left turn and heads toward Macungie (Routes 29 and 100 split at this point). • In the town of Macungie, turn right onto Poplar Street (second street after the stoplight).
