Treasurers Report

- STCA recorded Net Income loss of -\$6,984 in April primarily from production of Bagpiper 2023 #1. This brings the Club's YTD Net Income loss to -\$5,548. The Club's Balance Sheet Net Assets stand at \$558,400.
- Listed below are the accounts with income and expense over ~\$500 this month.
 - Income
 - \$ 1,767 Investment (interest)
 - \$ 900 Bagpiper 2023#2 (ad sales, partial)
 - o Expense
 - -\$ 8,704 Bagpiper 2023#1 (production, partial)
 - -\$ 600 Insurance (club liability)
 - -\$ 430 Taxes (quarterly deposit)
- Other Activities
 - 2023 Investments; CD matured in April; reinvestment in a new CD for \$80,000, with \$55,000 coming from the retired CD, \$20,000 coming from retained earnings transferred from checking and the balance from surplus cash paid by CD investments during the last period.
 - Portfolio is averaging 2.65% interest (\$9,150 in the last year), and the newest CD is paying 4.9% interest.
